First of all, we have a new member on staff, Matthew Humenik. It has created a bit of confusion with telephone callers because we now have two Matt's in the office. Matt O'Donnell is our Apprentice Funeral Director, and Matt Humenik is our Office Associate, Social Media Director, and General maintenance man for the facility. Secondly, we have made some updates to the facility. In the large visitation room, we combined a fresh coat of paint along with wallpaper below the chair rail. These are subtle changes, but they bring a new warmth to the room. Another thing you'll notice in the visitation room are two large 55" flat screen monitors. These monitors each have a DVD player so that visitors can enjoy the slideshow from anywhere in the room. There is no need to be huddled around a small screen on a table.

A third item is an innovation which has become a popular option for our families. When we have families having visitation from 2-4 and 6-8 we invite the immediate family to stay with us between calling hours, and we provide a catered meal for them so that they can get off their feet, enjoy a nice meal, have some down time, and not have to worry about where they're going to eat, who's car are they're driving, and how soon they have to get back.

Fourthly, we have initiated a new service for our families who purchase their casket and burial vault from us. We offer our 8 passenger limousine at no additional cost. Many families would like to purchase the use of a limo, but it's often on the "chopping block" of extra expenses. We offer this service as a way of giving our families the best value for dollars spent.
